B-17 Restoration

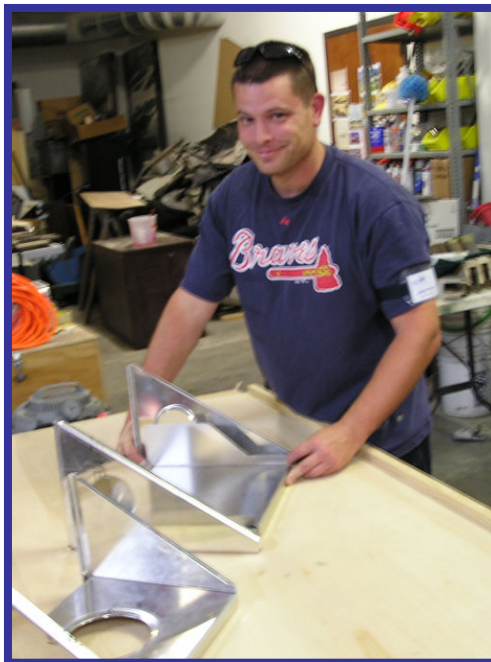
